

After leading the North Stanly High School football team to back-to-back winning seasons, Ralph Jackson is heading to Anson to serve as the new football coach for the Bearcats.

Jackson will start on March 2, and will also teach history at Anson High School. He replaces Luke Hyatt, who was the head football coach from 2009-2014.

Jackson is a native of Stanly County, graduating from West Stanly High School, where he still holds the school record for career rushing yards with 3,591. He led the North Stanly Colts to a 9-3 record season in 2014, with a nine-win season in 2013 also. Hee been the North Stanly Coach for five years.

young men and make a difference in their lives. My focus is the team that Iøm with í I want them to see that Iøm a guy that has family values and a real strong conviction.ö

Anson County Schools Superintendent Michael Freeman said he was pleased with the selection of Jackson as the new football coach and high school history teacher. õWe are very excited about him accepting our offer,ö Freeman said. õHe brings a background in coaching that should be very beneficial for our athletics.ö

Jackson said hes looking forward to meeting the players and staff and other students at Anson.

õMy ultimate goal is to have these young men getting back to dominance and return that rich winning tradition to Anson.ö Jackson said.
