Week of Young Child Parade in Downtown Wadesboro

Hundreds of children participated in the Week of the Young Child parade in Wadesboro on Tuesday morning April 14.

Approximately 450 people ô including child care providers, teachers, and about 400 children ô gathered in front of the Ansonia Theatre on Rutherford Street before marching to Parsonøs Drugs at the intersection of Wade and Greene streets, repeating the route twice.

Kindergartners from Wadesboro Primary School, Lilesville Elementary School, Peachland-Polkton Elementary School, and Ansonville Elementary School all visited the theater for a performance of õMike Mulligan and his Steam Shovelö before marching in the parade.

Three classrooms from Central Head Start NC Pre-K classrooms also marched in the parade and watched the show. NC Pre-K students from Morven Head Start, Open

Open Doors, and Anson Childrenøs Center also participated in the parade. Children from Cøs and Tøs Childcare also participated in the parade, according to Bonnie Morgan, the community outreach and literacy coordinator for the Anson County Partnership for Children, which sponsored the event.

The parade is part of the celebration of the Week of the Young Child that the Partnership celebrates each year. This year, the theme was õMike Mulligan and His Steam Shovel,ö a childrenøs book written by Virginia Lee Burton and originally published in 1939.

Many parade participants dressed as or carried models of the book characters. As they marched, the children passed a modern backhoe that town staff placed on the route so that children could compare Mary Anne to the newer model. In addition to the showing of õMike Mulligan and his Steam Shovelö for children, the Ansonia had an evening showing that was free and open to the general public. All performances of the show were given by the Resident Touring Company of Children Theatre of Charlotte (formerly Tarradiddle Players).

Children who participated in the parade or visited the public performance were given a free book to take home.
