Celebrate Agriculture at the 2013 Anson Ag Expo & Fair




It is that time of year again. Fall will be here before we know it, and so will the annual festivals and celebrations. While making plans for your family fall events, mark your calendars to attend the ninth annual 2013 Anson Ag Expo & Fair.

Set for the weekend of September 27 and 28, the two-day festival will take place on the Lockhart-Taylor Center campus of South Piedmont Community College in Wadesboro. Event hours are 6-9 pm on Friday evening and 9-4 pm on Saturday.

All of the popular activities are returning for this year for a variety of entertainment and opportunities. On the lineup for this year:

New fair books this year will include information on these and other activities available. This year book format will feature complete guidelines and registration procedures for all events within the two-day festival. Be on the lookout for them to arrive sometime in August.

Last year Ag Expo & Fair drew a crowd of 1750 for the week events. There were 76 youth from 11 counties in the livestock show, showing 110 animals. The fair had 380 exhibits, and 85 youth participated in children events through the day.




