Changes Planned for This Year's Celebration of Agriculture



It is that time of year again. Fall will be here before we know it, and so will all the annual festivals and celebrations. To get ready, the Anson Ag Expo & Fair Planning Committee is also preparing for their 2014 event. Mark your calendars for the weekend of September 26-27. However, due to some location issues, this year format will be different.

Set for the weekend of September 26 and 27, the festival will take place at Circle G Arena in Lilesville and the Cooperative Extension Center on McLaurin Street in Wadesboro. The annual 4-H Youth Livestock Show will be held at Circle G Arena on Friday and Saturday, while the Ag Fair will be held at the Extension Center on Saturday only. Due to having the events in different locations, the full Expo as has been held in past years will be on hiatus for 2014.

The 4-H Youth Livestock Show will begin at 6:00 pm on Friday with the Pee Wee and regular Youth Goat Show. The

arena will start back up again at 9:00 am on Saturday with the Pee Wee, Dairy and 4-H Youth Heifer Show, followed by the 4-H Youth Lamb Show. Last year sevent featured 79 youth from 9 different counties showing 119 lambs, goats and heifers in the district showmanship circuit.

The Ag Fair will be open to the public on Saturday from 9:00 am until 2:00 pm and will feature the traditional competition categories in foods, crafts, horticulture, ag, photography and art. Fair entries will be received on Thursday, judged on Friday, then open to the public on Saturday. Last year fair had 304 entries from 73 participants.

Because the public looks forward each year to some of the established events that are normally part of the Expo, the planning committee felt they could not just cancel them because of a location situation. Therefore, some of those events will be hosted as part of the newly revamped Taste of the Pee

Dee Festival that will be taking place two weeks later on Saturday, October 11 in downtown Wadesboro. Those will include the Local Foods Bake-Off, Kiddie Tractor Pull and Creative Squash Challenge.

Last year & Ag Expo & Fair drew a crowd of 1500 for the week events. Sponsor request letters have been mailed, and businesses have already responded in support of the this year & agricultural festival.
