Chuck Newton, Ellerbe and Mark Cabrera, Peachland walked away with top honors in the buck and doe categories in the 13th annual Big-Game Hunt Tournament.

Newton's 10-point, 162.6-pound buck was worth \$800 in total prize money but fell short of eclipsing the tournament record currently held by Lee Efird of Kannapolis, whose 171.1-pounder took top honors last year. J.R. Perrero, Indian Trail placed second with an eightpoint, 152-pounder and pocketed \$475, followed by Bobby Sikes, Wadesboro, eight-point, 144.7, \$350; Garrett Treadaway, Peachland, eight-point, 141.7, \$175; Clint Mabry, Marshville, eight-point, 141.2, \$75; and John Hill, Peachland, seven-point, 139.6, free 2011 tournament registration plus \$100 daily prize.

Cabrera weighed in a 116.4-pound doe to earn \$800 in total prize money. David Kelly, Morven placed second with a 111.1-pounder for \$500, followed by Larry Williams, Wadesboro, 102.1, \$375; Colby Zimmerman, Thomasville, 100.9, \$200; Richard Bates, Lexington, 100.1, \$75; and Mark Ross, Peachland, a free 2011 Big-Game Hunt registration plus \$75 in daily prize money.

In the youth buck category, Hunter Hicks, Norwood won the \$300 prize with a record-setting nine-point, 169.3pounder. Kayla Randall, Norwood placed second in the buck category with a ninepoint, 134.8-pounder worth \$175, followed by Hunter Williams, Marshville, 10-point, 121.3, \$100; Joshua Cabrera, Peachland, seven-point, 117.1, \$65; and Wesley Barefoot, Raleigh, three-point, 117.1, free 2011 registration and a \$25 daily prize.

Mason Coble, Mt. Gilead won the youth doe category with a 98.4-pounder worth \$300. 
