Blood Drive turnout is low again!

A blood drive at First Presbyterian Church in Wadesboro collected 21 units of blood on Wednesday.

The drive was conducted by the Red Cross, which regularly holds drives at the church. There were 19 donations of blood and two units of double red cells. The Red Cross has lowered its expectations at Anson after regularly failing to reach the usual goal of 40 units of blood. However, the drive still failed to meet the new goal of 28 units.

The Red Cross has considered canceling the drives because the personnel must travel to the site. Regular drives at schools and colleges bolster the blood supply, especially after seasonal lows in turnout like during the summer months. Drives that are sponsored by a group in the community typically collect more blood. The blood supply is usually supported by regular donors.

The Red Cross also makes efforts to remind donors of drives through post-cards and phone calls.

AEDC's Micro-Loan Program!

The Anson Economic Development Corporation has launched a micro loan program to assist aspiring entrepreneurs in Anson County.

Through the new program, interest-free loans of up to \$500 are available to help with start-up operations or to assist businesses that have been in operation for less than a year. Loan funds may not be used for working capital; they are intended primarily to help with start-up costs.

"The cornerstone of AEDC's mission is to stimulate economic growth in Anson County," said Chuck Horne, president of Hornwood, Inc., and chairman of the AEDC. "This is a way we can provide assistance to home-grown businesses without risking a great deal of capital." Before the loan committee will consider a loan request, the applicant must complete a comprehensive business plan endorsed by the Small Business Center at South Piedmont Community College or New Ventures Business Development, Inc. Loan applications are available through the Anson County Chamber of Commerce.

Loans are available only to businesses

that will be located in Anson County. The minimum loan amount is \$100. While the loans are interest free, a \$20 processing fee will be charged. Repayment must be made within one year.

"We frequently hear that access to small amounts of capital is a major obstacle to some small business start-ups," Horne said. "We hope the AEDC micro loan program will help Anson County entrepreneurs overcome that hurdle." The Anson Economic Development Corporation is a privately funded 501(c)(3) non-profit that operates under the auspices of the Anson County Chamber of Commerce.

Local Authors Publish Novel!




